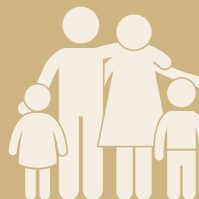

Feeding the Hungry Every Day

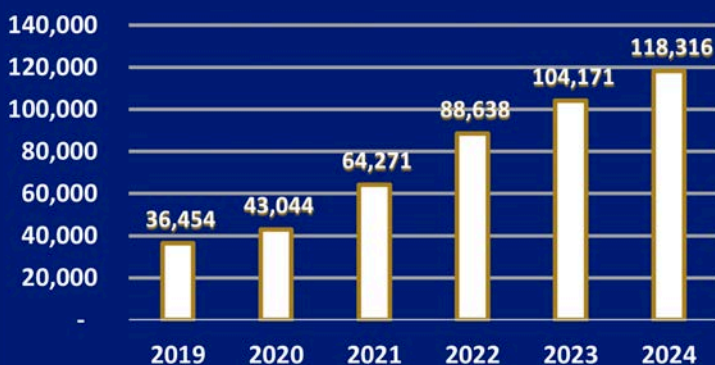

This winter, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, through our vital partnership with *Empowerment Plan*, distributed 42 life-saving convertible sleeping bag coats to our neighbors experiencing homelessness. With shelter beds scarce and affordable housing out of reach for so many in our area, these coats were a lifeline.

These remarkable coats, which transform into insulated sleeping bags, provided not only warmth but reassurance to individuals and families facing the harsh realities of winter without shelter. Each one delivered a powerful message: *you are seen, you are valued, and you are not alone.*

From the mother keeping her child warm on a freezing night, to the veteran trying to get back on his feet, your support reached them when they needed it most.

Home Visits: The Heart of Our Mission

Our most personal and powerful Vincentian tradition of service is that of the home visit. Conducted by a team of trained SVdP volunteers, these visits are never about judgment; they're about personal connection, care and stabilizing a family in crisis.

During the home visit, volunteers listen, pray, offer guidance, and determine what programs and services are needed to stabilize the family and set them on a path to becoming self-sufficient. Neighbors are also connected to other wraparound community resources and program services.

Regardless of race, religion, or background, we never stand above those we serve—we sit beside them, walk with them, and remind them they are not alone. Our goal is not just to ease today's burden, but to offer comfort, support and the possibility of a better tomorrow.

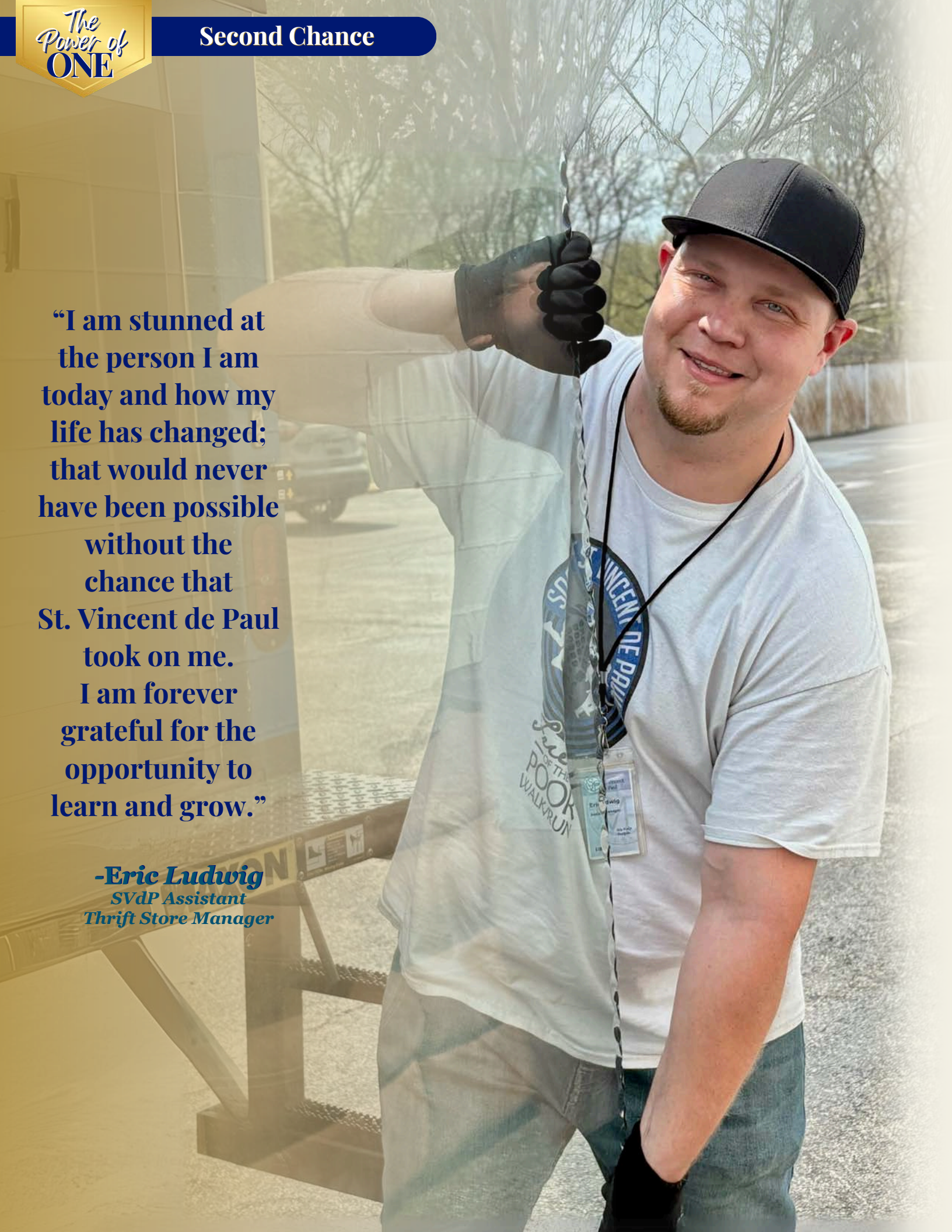

Sometimes, all it takes is one hand-up, one opportunity, one mentor and one second chance to change a life.

One opportunity can change the trajectory of a life. That's the foundation of our Ready2Work program and we take that simple premise to heart with every single candidate we enroll.

➤ ***One person who gains the skills and confidence to succeed in the workforce.***

➤ ***One job that brings dignity, stability, and purpose.***

➤ ***One family that finds hope and a path out of poverty.***

➤ ***One community made stronger because of it.***

The Ready2Work program is more than just job training - it's about helping people rediscover their worth and take real steps toward stability and purpose. Our curriculum also includes life skills, financial literacy and career assessment. Each participant is matched with a trained mentor who

provides one-on-one support throughout their journey, taking that first step toward a better future. And it works.

Eric is living proof.

Two years ago, Eric came to us through our collaborating partner, Flying High, at the very beginning of his recovery. After years of homelessness,, addiction, and felony convictions, he didn't believe a different life was possible. But Ready2Work gave him the tools, support, and encouragement to try.

Eric started in our thrift store, learning job skills, showing up every day, and pushing himself to grow. His transformation - from program participant to SVdP leader - is a testament to the power of education and mentorship. Today, he's our Assistant Store Manager, leading with character and confidence.

Together, through the power of one second chance we are building a stronger, more hopeful community.

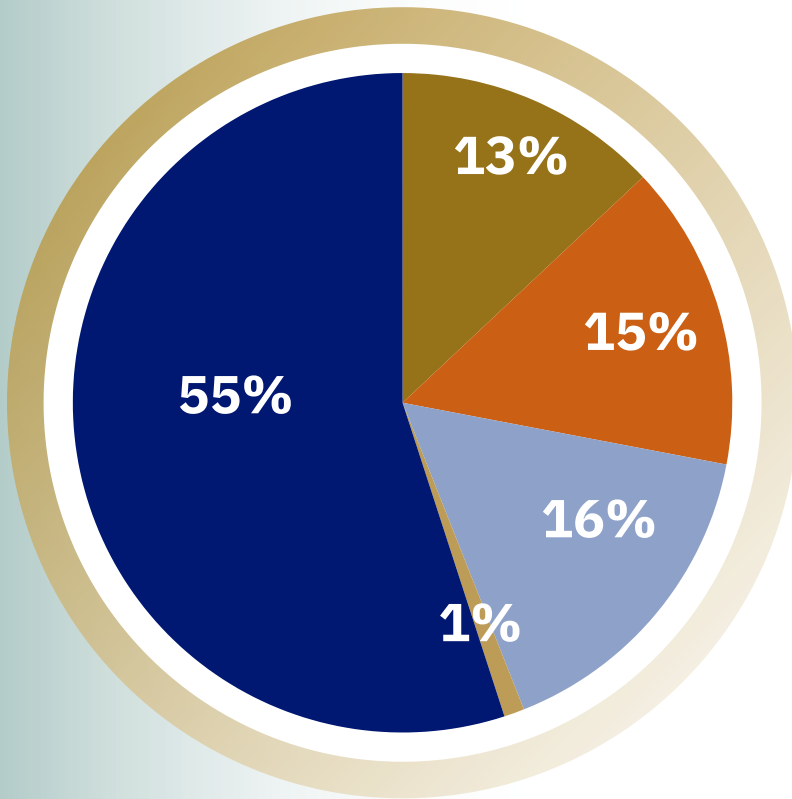

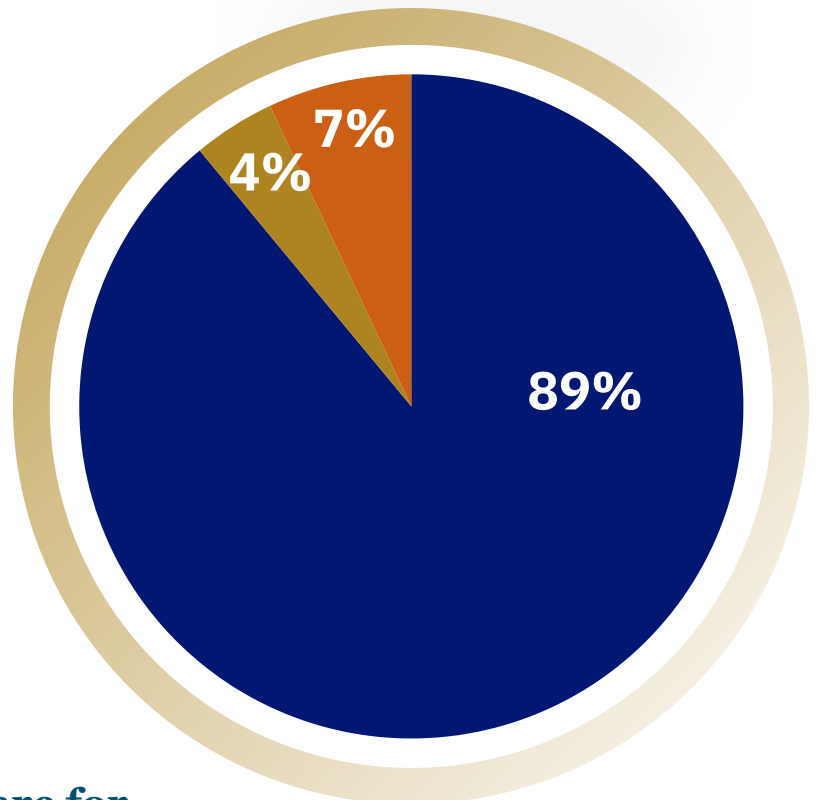
